Aloha Pacific Federal Credit Union's KALABASH ATM Network Adds University of Hawaii location

KALABASH is Hawaii's largest credit union ATM network

*A non-member cash withdrawal fee of 95 cents makes it more affordable
for all UH students, especially those from out-of-state*

HONOLULU – Aloha Pacific Federal Credit Union (Aloha Pacific) expands its ATM network by adding a new location at the University of Hawaii's Campus Center. The ATM is in partnership with University of Hawaii Federal Credit Union. An official ATM blessing by Kahu Solomon "Hotch" Kekoa will take place at the University of Hawaii on Thursday, Sept. 13 at 10 a.m.

With more than 40 ATMs, Aloha Pacific's KALABASH is the largest credit union ATM network in Hawaii. In addition to all Aloha Pacific branches and Macy's stores throughout Hawaii, KALABASH machines are conveniently located at various tourist locations, city and federal buildings and police stations. KALABASH ATMs are also at other credit unions, such as Hawaii Central Credit Union and Hawaii Federal Credit Union.

KALABASH continues to provide affordable non-member ATM access, especially helpful to out-of-state students. Unlike most financial institutions that surcharge an average of \$2 and independent machines that surcharge up to \$5, KALABASH ATMs only surcharge 95 cents per withdrawal.

"We are committed to delivering high quality, affordable financial services," said Wallace Watanabe, Aloha Pacific president and CEO. "There are many residents, businesses and non-residents that can benefit from our checking and savings accounts, loans, investments, realty services and the most extensive credit union ATM network in Hawaii."

Aloha Pacific recently changed its name from Honolulu City & County Employees Federal Credit Union, but the KALABASH ATM network remained the same. Aloha Pacific continues to be a member of the CO-OP Network, giving members surcharge-free access to over 25,000 ATMs throughout the U.S. and Canada.

Aloha Pacific will soon open a three-story flagship branch in the heart of downtown Honolulu. Located across from Macy's and next to Pioneer Plaza, it will occupy two floors and the basement of the former Servco Pacific Building. The branch will be open weekdays from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.
