Aloha Pacific Federal Credit Union Wins 2010 Best Places to Work

HONOLULU—Aloha Pacific Federal Credit Union (Aloha Pacific) was named 2010 *Best Places to Work in Hawaii*. This is the second year in a row it has won as a medium-sized company.

Best Places to Work in Hawaii comprises 60 companies in three groups: 25 small companies (25-49 employees), 18 medium companies (50-149 employees) and 17 large companies (150 or more employees).

It is sponsored by ProService Hawaii and published annually by *Hawaii Business* magazine. The company data are gathered and analyzed by an independent research organization, Best Companies Group. This awards program is designed to identify, recognize and honor the best places of employment in Hawaii.

To participate, companies must fulfill the following requirements:

- Be a for-profit, not-for-profit business or government entity;
- Have a facility in the state of Hawaii;
- Have a minimum of 25 employees working in Hawaii;
- Must be in business a minimum of 1 year.

Best Companies Group managed a two-part survey process to determine the *Best Places to Work in Hawaii*. The first part evaluated each company's workplace policies, practices, philosophy, systems and demographics. The second part measured the employee experience through a survey.
