Aloha Pacific Federal Credit Union Opens Kapolei Branch

HONOLULU—Aloha Pacific Federal Credit Union (Aloha Pacific) announced today the opening of its Kapolei branch, the ninth location on Oahu. Located at 1001 Kamokila Blvd., Suite 104, the branch is near the Kapolei police station and public library.

The Kapolei branch is a full-service community-style branch with evening and weekend hours (9:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. on weekdays and 9:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. on Saturday). Service to members will be conducted face-to-face and are available today to Aloha Pacific members and for shared branch transactions. The KALABASH ATM is open to everyone.

The branch will feature a coin counting machine and Kala Cafe, a free WiFi internet café with self-service espresso machine, for members. This location also offers more than 560 safe deposit boxes for rent. Boxes come in two sizes: 3" x 10" for \$50 per year and 5" x 10" for \$60 per year.
