## **Aloha Pacific Federal Credit Union Donates \$21,000 To Kapiolani Children's Miracle Network**

**HONOLULU** — Aloha Pacific Federal Credit Union raised \$21,000 in support of Kapiolani Children's Miracle Network (KCMN) and presented the check today, February 1, 2012, to Stacey Acma, director of philanthropy for Hawaii Pacific Health and director of Kapiolani Children's Miracle Network.

The funds were raised from June 15, 2011, to January 23, 2012, through the sale of baked goods, plate lunches, handmade crafts, jewelry, a car wash, KCMN paper balloons and the iDcard (Isle Discount card), which entitles its holders to special discounts and offers at Island restaurants and other retail establishments. Coin canisters were also placed at every branch. In addition, Aloha Pacific staffers took part in the nationwide Miracle Jeans Day, in which, for a minimum \$5 donation, they could "dress down" in a red, yellow, blue or white shirt – matching the theme colors of KCMN – and jeans to spread the word about KCMN.
