Aloha Pacific Federal Credit Union Donates over \$11,500 to Kapiolani Children's Miracle Network

HONOLULU—Aloha Pacific Federal Credit Union (Aloha Pacific) raised \$11,525.28 in support of Kapiolani Children's Miracle Network (KCMN) and presented the check to Stacey Acma, director of philanthropy for foundations of Hawaii Pacific Health and Kapiolani Children's Miracle Network, Tuesday.

The funds were raised during a two-month period, from March 30 to May 30. Proceeds were raised from the sale of baked goods, Entertainment Books and KCMN paper balloons. Coin canisters at every branch also helped the fundraising efforts.



The fundraising efforts are part of the Credit Union for Kids program and support the many services provided by Kapiolani Medical Center for Women and Children that are not covered by insurance.
